

### Certificate of Apprenticeship (C of A) Certificate of Qualification (C of Q)

Upon successful completion of the apprenticeship program, apprentices must write a final examination with the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities. Successful apprentices will be entitled to a Certificate of Apprenticeship and the provincial Certification of Qualification (C. of Q.). In addition, a St. Lawrence College Statement of Achievement will be awarded for completion of the Basic and a St. Lawrence College Certificate is issued upon completion of both levels.

#### PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

This program includes all the in-school training required to complete the requirements of the Apprenticeship Program as defined by the Apprenticeship Branch of the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities.

This Hairstylist Apprenticeship Program is an alternative to the 48-week Ontario certificate program. It will appeal to individuals currently employed in a salon who are working toward obtaining the provincial Certificate of Qualification as a Hairstylist.

Apprenticeship training is recognized as one of the most efficient methods of training and educating skilled tradespersons. Flexible in-school training options are necessary to meet the specific needs of apprentices and their training sponsor or employer.

Apprentices learn to become qualified trades people or “journeypersons” while sponsors or employers gain highly skilled employees with current knowledge and work techniques. St. Lawrence College provides the academic training, in cooperation with the Apprenticeship and Client Services Branch of the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities.
