Trades Fee	C (Program Specific) <sup>6</sup>	\$10/term \$20 max/yr	Used to recoup expenses incurred by the College for students' personal take home projects – such as nails, glue, electrodes in welding shop, supplies used on students' personal vehicles in the auto shop, etc.

Music and Digital Media Applied Lesson Fee	K (Program Specific) <sup>11</sup>	\$500 Sem 1 & 3 \$605 Sem 2 & 4	Covers mandatory applied music lessons which occur once per week throughout every semester of the program and the juried assessment that happens as a culminating event for these lessons at the end of second and fourth semester.
